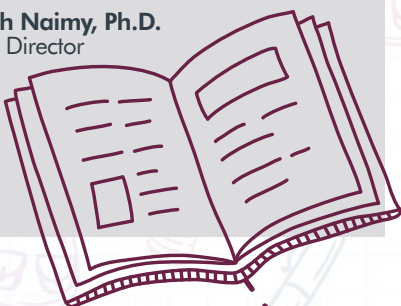

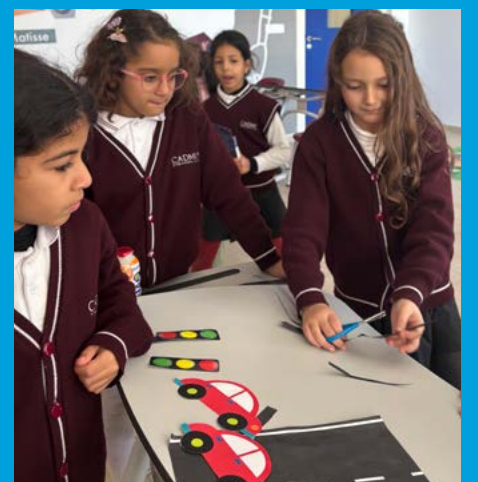

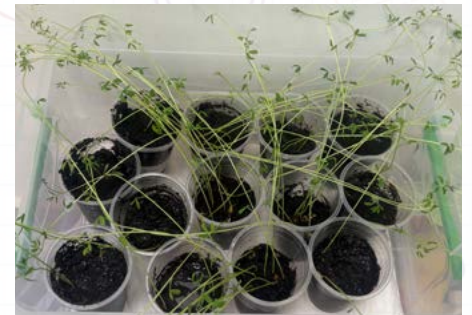


Learning Beyond the Classroom

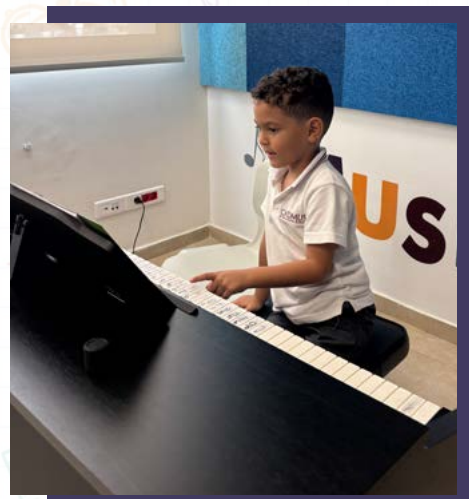

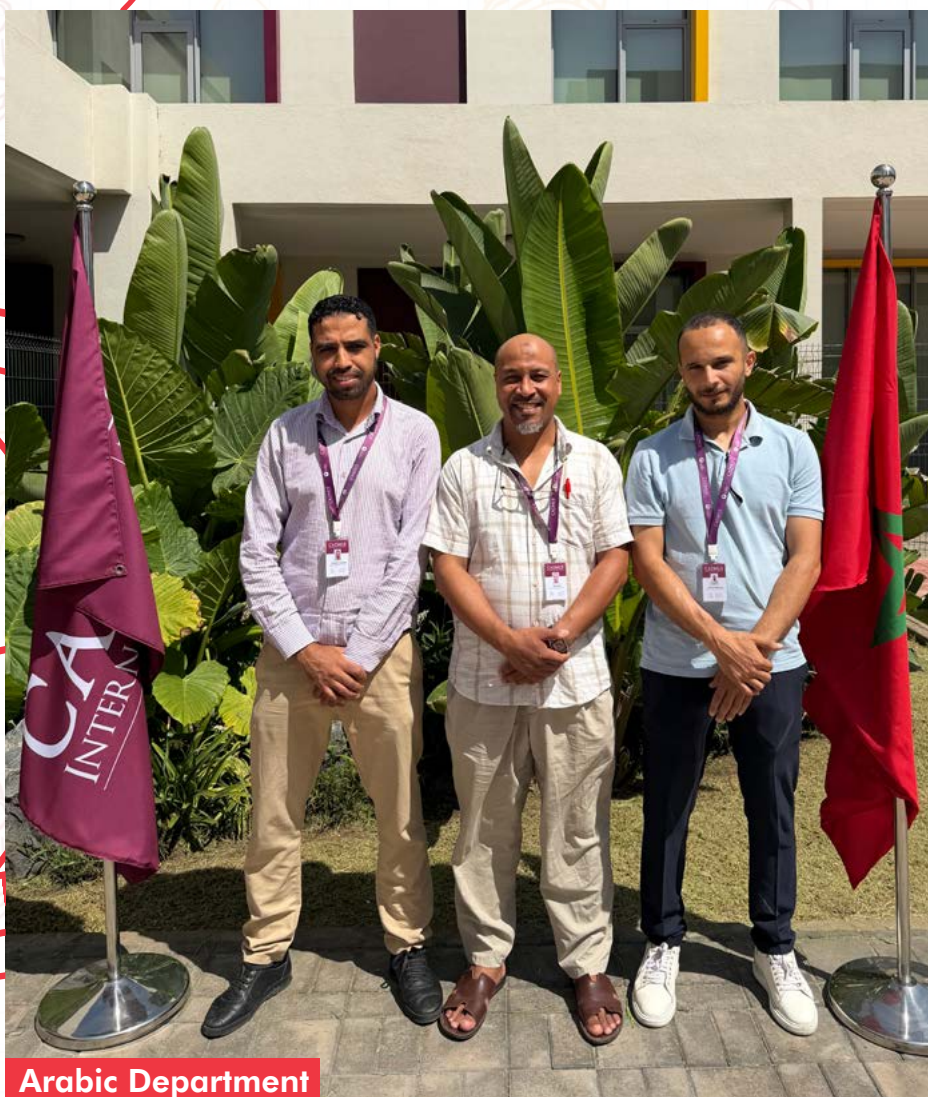
