


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


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

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## A WORD FROM OUR LEADERS


I am confident that CADMUS® Zenata will continue to strengthen its academic excellence and prepare students to become confident and successful learners.








## Shadow Teaching





## SCHOOL TRIPS



## Zoo Visit






## Breast Cancer Awareness
